**Questions to help you determine if you are actively employed in the industry.**

1. If the construction industry folded tomorrow, would your company still exist?

If NO, you are actively employed in industry. If YES, answer question #2.

2. Would you have the same job within the company?

If NO, you are actively employed in industry. If YES, you must be an ASSOCIATE member.

\*Must be enrolled in a construction-related: program at an institution of higher education, vocational program or apprenticeship program.

\*\*Must be retired, and at least 62 years of age.

\*\*\*Must be actively employed in the construction industry in a country outside of the United States.
